The August meeting of the Goshen Township Trustees took place on Monday August 5, 2024 at the Goshen Township Hall Allen called the meeting to order at 5:30 PM

Minutes were read and approved, Motion made Allen approved the Minutes as presented. Seconded by Joe (3 yes- 0 nay)

Tammy presented the following financial reports with the board members: bank statements as well as the Bank Rec for each month, Star Ohio & Quest statements, Revenue Status report as of 7/1/2024, Receipt Listing, Payment Listing, Appropriation Status by Fund as of 7/31//2024, Comparison of Budget and Appropriated funds report and Appropriation Supplemental report for the year.

Upon certification from the Fiscal Officer that funds were available, Joe motioned to pay invoices and payroll as presented. Motion seconded Daryl (3 yes-0 nays) With no further discussion, checks were distributed and signed.

Old Business:

Budget committee resolution was discussed, after a brief discussion Daryl motioned to accept the current formula used for Local Government Distribution Joe second the motion. (3 yes-0 nays)

New Business

Fiscal officer discussed the change with Quest FCU credit card rewards program. Daryl motion to remove Goshen Townships credit card from the program not earning cash back. Allen second the motion (3 yes 0 nays)

Legge's Excavating LLC bid snow removal for Goshen Township for the 2024-2025 winter. Daryl motion to accept the bid as submitted with Joe seconding the motion (3 yes 0 nays)

Board of Health mailed Goshen's budget for 2025 = \$7860.00.

Fiscal officer reached out to Middlefield Bank with questions and was offered the current rate of 4.50% for the Townships Money Market checking account and Money Market accounts.

Roads:

Hardin County North of 309 has been completed.

Zoning:

A Weaver property on St Rt 67 needs to survey off 3 acres from his business according to the Health Dept.

Joe will call Joe Holland about his property.

Bob will send a letter to the occupants at the Oborn Sawmill, Keller properties.

Zoning committee meeting is still needed.

Trustee Sherman motioned to waive the opening and closing cost for Paul Rickenbacher. Paul had the contract to mow the McKendree cemetery for the past 69 years. Daryl seconded the motion 3 yes 0 nays.

Trustee Sherman motion to have Paul's wife Nancy fulfill his mowing contract for the remainder of 2024 Daryl seconded the motion 3 yes 0 nays

Trustee Sherman report the cemetery has been busy and is preparing for mausoleum project to begin after Sept. 1, 2024.

Trustee Flowers reported the Health Dept. needs to fill position.

Looking to appoint Jordan Temple to the advisory Board.

Suggestion was made for the Health dept. to use the UAN system for budgets etc.

There being no further business brought before the Board, Joe motioned to adjourn the meeting at 6:09PM. Second by Allen motion carried.
